
FIRE SAFETY —SECOND LEVEL (2) HOAX CALLS



This activity is designed to allow children to consider the consequences of making a hoax call to the emergency services. They should listen to both phone calls and try to decide which one is a Hoax.

Which call do you think is real and which one do you think is a hoax? Why?	They are both hoax calls
Was it hard to distinguish between the real call and the hoax call?	It is very difficult to distinguish between a hoax call and a real call, therefore a fire engine is always sent.
What else might be happening while the fire service are attending a hoax call?	Someone's house could be on fire. There could be a road accident that the fire service need to attend.
What might be the consequences of making a hoax call ?(please record children's answers if you have time)	 This list is not exhaustive: You could be charged by the police as it is an offence to make a hoax call Someone who is trapped in a fire will have to wait longer to be rescued There will be more damage to a house that is on fire as it will take longer for the fire service to be able to attend. Someone who is injured in a car accident would have to wait longer to be rescued
Who might be affected by a hoax call being made?	 The person making the call as they may be charged by the police. The parents of the child who makes the hoax call as they will be very disappointed. The fire service, there time is valuable, every second counts when there is a fire and they can't afford for there time to be wasted.
